

WALK 1

Penisar Mynydd Caravan Park through local lanes and meadows (incorporating part of the Clwydian Way).

Duration of walk : 30 minutes

Description : A short circular walk that is ideal just before or after a meal, or to take the dog!. Please keep your dog on a lead!.



The 'Clwydian Way' is a 122 mile circular long distance path in North Wales, created for the millenium, that starts and ends in Prestatyn.

From the park, turn right and follow the road for 100 yards until you reach a junction to a country lane on your right.

Turn right and follow the country lane downhill for 250 yards until the road bears right.

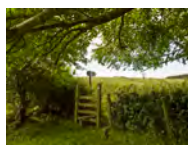
As the road bears right, a stile leads into the field on your left. Climb the stile and cross the field, part of the Clwydian Way.

Keep to the left of the field to reach another stile at the end of the field. Climb the stile and continue to the top left corner of the field.

You will find another stile in the corner of the field that leads onto a country lane. Turn left and follow the country lane for 500 yards going slightly uphill.

On reaching a T junction, turn left. Follow the road for quarter of a mile back to the caravan park.
