

WALK 2

Penisar Mynydd Caravan Park to Mynydd-y-Cwm woods (incorporating part of Offa's Dyke)

Duration of walk : 1 hour, 15 minutes

1



From the caravan park, turn left and follow the road past the wooded area on the right called "Tir Comen", and then past a white farm house.

At the road junction (near the sign for "Glan Llyn"), turn right onto a single track country lane. Follow the road slightly uphill for half a mile. At the crossroads, continue straight on.

On reaching the woods on the left, ignore the lane leading off to the left but proceed to the gate leading into the forest. Climb over the gate (or fence), and continue up the forest track, slightly uphill.

At the open area at the top of the hill, there are fine views to the left towards the Clwydian Hills. Continue along the track back into the forest.

When the forest track reaches a T junction, turn left to follow the forest track in a circular manner around the summit of Mynydd-y-Cwm.

Eventually you will notice the views to your left becoming more open. Just after another forest track joins from the right, you will see a style on your left. Climb over the style onto a gravel track, and go right downhill. Notice the hill of Moel Hiraddug to your left.

Shortly you will reach a gate and style. Climb over the style to reach a country lane. Go left for 20 yards to reach another style with a sign post for Offas Dyke and Marian Cwm. Climb over the style and proceed across the field keeping the hedge/fence to your right.

Description : A circular walk that incorporates pretty country lanes, a walk through the forest, across fields (following part of Offa's Dyke long distance path), and finally country lanes once more.

Highlights : An ideal walk with dogs who can explore the wooded areas. Offers great views of the Clwydian Hills, and the local villages of Marian Cwm and Trelawnyd.

Follow the yellow arrows across the field to reach another style, leading onto another country lane. Climb the style and turn right down the country lane.

Follow the country lane for half a mile. Notice the village of Trelawnyd in the distance to your left, with Gop Hill behind it. This is the site of ancient human habitation.

Just after passing a farm on the right, you reach a road junction. Continue straight ahead and then to the right, ignoring the lane leading off to the immediate right. Follow the road for quarter of a mile leading you back to the caravan park.
